Since You Asked

A few weeks ago the Killen congregation was afforded an opportunity to help with storm relief. A volunteer with ties to an established relief group decided they would take supplies in our covered trailer to Texas where the Disaster Assistance Team would be stationed in League City. The decision was contingent on a quick departure on the following Friday. The congregation has only a Wednesday night notice to come up with funds and supplies. With your overwhelming and quick response, the church was able to purchase over \$6,000 worth of supplies including: food that needed no preparation, breakfast bars, meat in easy open cans, sweets and high protein snacks, water and Gatorade, toothbrushes, razors, feminine products, diapers, etc. We, including a couple from the Rogersville congregation, loaded most of that on the trailer and in my vehicle Friday evening. The trailer left, with an escort of one and an American flag flapping in the wind, early Saturday morning. It was an eventful trip with two flat tires and an unplanned overnight stay still 3-4 hours from our destination. With the help of my brother-in-law in his separate vehicle, I was able to purchase two new trailer tires and they finished up the trip.

When we arrived in League City, we unloaded our trailer and helped put together over a thousand quick-meals. The meals were accompanied by literature about the local congregation. There were distributed to various hotels in the area to residents displaced by the flood. We also helped with food distribution personally in a small trailer park in the flooded area. This was repeated every day we were there. Along with helping to unload other vehicles as they arrived, I traveled to a local hardware and food stores looking for other supplies. I was able to purchase a pallet of bleach to be added to the supplies in the distribution center at the League Center Church. We want to recognize the League Church of Christ for their willingness as a distribution center and their volunteers for their time and efforts. One volunteer was particularly interesting. She was a young girl of about 10 or 11, in a wheelchair having no use of either of her legs. This in no way hampered her desire or ability to help with moving supplies within the distribution center. What an example for us all!
