GREETINGS FROM THE NORTH ALABAMA CHRISTIAN CHILDREN'S HOME

On behalf of our Staff, our Board of Directors, and especially our fourteen children, ages 9-18, we want to thank you for all you do for us here at North Alabama Christian Children's Home. We hope the best of 2018 will be yours!

We had a great year in 2017! We had our largest number of children present, with every bed full and 22 children on campus at the end of the school year last May! Since then, some children have gone home. And we presently have 14 children (10 girls and 4 boys.) All except two of them are teenagers, and they lead active lives! We had several teens play volleyball, basketball and one young man who played Varsity football for Rogers. We have two seniors this year on campus, and one of them has already fulfilled her course requirements for graduation. Another of our seniors was chosen by her peers to be on the Homecoming Senior Court!

Our Children had a tremendous summer, with Maywood camp being one of the highlights. Three of our young ladies gave their lives to Christ while there, and in the last 10 years some 30 of our children have become New Testament Christians! Our children had a fantastic Christmas, and we thank all those who helped bring presents their way! Our Children are excited about attending CYC, and some of our children will be involved in Lads to Leaders also!

The new Buffer Administration and Counseling Center is coming along well. The outside of the building is complete, except for the front canopy. Last week, brethren from Cox Blvd. put up the stud walls for the offices and rooms that will be in this building. We hope to complete this building later on this spring.

We are looking for faithful Christian house parents for the Boys home. This is a fulltime position, and we need to find someone in the next few months. Additionally, we need respite help, so that our present house parents can take off 1 day a week for rest and relaxation. We normally have the Christian house mother/father come in to the home for a 24/hour period, allowing the house parents to take off. This too is a paid position, and those interested in either work should contact Melinda Jackson or Don Williams as soon as possible.

Our Biggest fundraiser is coming up March 2nd and 3rd! The 9th Annual Robert and Eva Coats Trail Ride and Auction will take place at the Coats horse farm at 1458 Co. Rd. 298 in the Zip City community. We will have a yard sale Friday-Saturday. On Saturday, folks can bring their horses and ride the trails, leaving out at 9 am. The silent auction and music begins at 10 and will consist of (3) 30-minute auctions, where one can write in their bids for gift cards, hotel stays, oil changes, and much more. Around 11:15, our food consisting of Chicken and Goat Stew, BBQ, Hamburgers/hotdogs, and Ham and beans will be ready to eat. It is all free, but a donation box will be provided for those who desire to give. At 12:30, the BIG auction begins, consisting of autographed footballs, new and used furniture, vacation stays, horses and hogs, quilts and horse tack, appliances, and so much more! Last year, we had over 800 people there. We raised over \$40,000! There will also be free cotton candy and a bounce house for kids! If you have items to donate to the Auction or yard sale, (no clothes please), we will be glad to arrange picking these items up as well.
